*** SHORT TERM REHABILITATIVE SERVICES**

D'Youville Senior Care's specially designed rehabilitation program provides short-term services and complex medical care to individuals transitioning from the hospital to their home (or another level of care) following an illness, injury, or surgery.

Conditions treated include, but are not limited to:

- ~ Orthopedic – fractures, joint replacements (hip, knee, shoulder)
- ~ Neurological – stroke, Parkinson's, post-aneurysm
- ~ Cardiac/Pulmonary – bypass, COPD
- ~ Post Surgical Care
- ~ Pain Management
- ~ Medical Management – post pneumonia, prolonged hospitalization
- ~ Wound Care, Intravenous Fluids/Antibiotics
- ~ Medication Management, Colostomy Care, Diabetic Teaching

A full range of physical, occupational, and speech therapy services are available 7 days a week to maximize one's functional ability and independence. If you are having elective surgery necessitating a short-term rehab stay following hospitalization, call us to arrange a pre-surgical tour.

*** DEMENTIA CARE - SPECIAL CARE UNITS**

Our dementia care program is dedicated to helping individuals with Alzheimer's and related dementias achieve the highest quality of life throughout the middle and late stages of their disease. The goal of the Special Care Units is to make each person feel safe, happy and content with a sense of purpose and belonging. Our two Special Care units, caring for 84 residents, provide support at all levels of cognitive, physical, psychosocial, and spiritual functioning, by enabling each person to maximize his or her abilities. We provide specialized programming with our highly trained staff, in a friendly and secure environment.

*** HOSPICE/PALLIATIVE CARE**

The goal of hospice care is to maximize quality of life to those with a terminal illness through expert pain control and symptom management while meeting physical, emotional, social and spiritual needs of the patient and family through end of life. The focus of palliative care is to provide a compassionate, comfortable pain-free experience. Care is provided through a collaborative team effort between specially trained D'Youville staff and hospice agency personnel.

*** LONG TERM SKILLED NURSING CARE**

We provide 24-hour skilled nursing care and an upbeat daily activity program. Our top notch nursing staff coupled with our dedicated and outgoing activities team, provide a fun and supportive environment for residents.

*** ADULT DAY HEALTH**

Our Adult Day Health program provides nursing care and health monitoring to frail and disabled seniors, Monday through Friday from 9:00AM to 3:00PM. Clients enjoy breakfast, lunch, a light snack, and a variety of activities. We can arrange for podiatry services and physical, occupational, and speech therapy when prescribed by a physician. We also have beauty salon and barber services on the premises.

Because of D'Youville's non-profit status, we established the D'Youville Foundation in 2002 to serve as a perpetual fund to benefit the residents and clients of D'Youville Senior Care.
